Elementary (PK-6)- Students can bring homework assignments they need help with or graded work to review if they did not master the concepts. Additionally, students may come 'empty handed' where they will work on pre-selected activities to focus on their area of skill need. Students may receive support in reading, writing, math, social studies or science. Students in 6th grade performing well in math & writing may push into a middle school level session (as noted with *).

Middle/ High School courses- Students should bring assignments they need support on or graded work they need to review. Additionally, students may come 'empty handed' where center staff will have work that will review current curriculum content and areas of needed support within the specified coursework.

Guided Study- Students will be supported by staff to study and prepare for an upcoming exam using a variety of strategies (e.g. making index cards, outlining essay points, or practicing examples). Students should bring their study materials (notes, textbook, study guide) TASK LI will provide physical materials (index cards, highlighters, etc.) Learn to study with relevant materials!

Literacy Lab- This skill session provides students more intensive reading support/instruction; staff will focus on fluency with a strong focus on comprehension skills.

Writers Workshop- This skill session, broken up into smaller groups, provides students with more intensive writing skill instruction. Students will become more comfortable putting their thoughts on paper in a well-structured format. Emphasis will be placed on the writing process and skills expected by current curriculum standards.

Mindfulness- Students will have the opportunity to learn strategies to attend to a topic more fully, be in the present moment and prioritize their thoughts. Mindfulness is a newer trend that is proving to benefit students in schools all over the world. Students will be able to generalize these skills to their everyday lives, including but not limited to, the classroom setting.

Parent Workshops- Various parent workshops will be offered to support parents individually and their children's educational success. Additional fees may apply.
